Sub: AICTE approval to the PSNA College of Engineering & Technology, Dindigul, Tamil Nadu

Sir,

I am directed to state that on the basis of the recommendations of the Expert Committee of the the Southern Regional Committee (SRC), the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) has granted approval to the PSNA College of Engineering & Technology, Dindigul, Tamil Nadu for conduct of the following existing four year Degree courses with the annual intakes indicated against each during the academic year 1993-94 only:-

Civil Engineering	60 (Sixty)
Mechanical Engineering	60 (Sixty)
Electronics & Communication Engineering	60 (Sixty)

This approval is subject to fulfilment of the following conditions:-

- 1) The marginal deficiency of 298.54 sq.mtrs. in building space should be made good to meet the requirements of AICTE.
- 2) The deficiencies in regard to laboratories and equipment should be rectified by the College.
- 3) The number of Computer terminals should be increased to meet the requirement of AICTE norms. The space for the Computer centre should also be increased to 180 sq.mtrs. UPS System has to be provided for the Computer centre.
- 4) The library titles should be increased to meet the AICTE norms. The College should subscribe for more journals of technical nature of national and international repute to fulfill the AICTE norms.
- 5) The cadre of Associate Lecturer should be abolished and the lowest cadre in the teaching faculty should be Lecturer as per AICTE norms.

- 6) The College should make immediate arrangements to provide training regarding conducting of experiments from Regional Engineering Colleges etc. to the teaching staff of the College. The teachers should also be provided with laboratory manual.
- 7) AICTE scales of pay should be implemented for all the teaching staff of the College.
- 8) Recurring expenditure per student per year should be brought up to AICTE norms of Rs. 11,916/- from the year 1992-93 onwards.
- 9) The Governing Council of the College should be reconstituted as per the guidelines of AICTE.
- 10) All admissions should be made as per the norms and guidelines of the AICTE as adopted by the State of Tamil Nadu.
- 11) The tuition and other fees should be charged as prescribed by the State Government within the overall criteria prescribed by the AICTE from time to time. No capitation fees should be charged from the students/ guardians of the students in any form.
- 12) The accounts of the Institute should be audited by a Chartered Accountant and should be open for inspection by the AICTE or anybody authorised by it.
- 13) The teaching and other staff should be recruited according to the procedure, guidelines and experience prescribed by the AICTE.
- 14) No new course should be started without the prior approval of the AICTE.
- 15) The intake in any of the approved courses should not be altered under any circumstances without the prior concurrence of the AICTE.

This approval is subject to full compliance with the provisions of the SCHEME as prescribed by the Supreme Court of India in its Judgment dated 4-2-1993 on Writ Petition (C) No. 607 of 1992.

The Management should strictly follow any further conditions as may be laid down by the AICTE from time to time.
